- Step 1: Start with Tech Week. ...
- Step 2: Add Full Runs & Act Runs. ...
- Step 3: Add All Call Rehearsals. ...
- Step 4: Add Large Group Rehearsals. ...
- Step 5: Schedule Children's Rehearsals. ...
- Step 6: Schedule The Hardest Scenes For Leads. ...
- Step 7: Schedule Solos And Duets And Trios.

The five phases are presented in turn, followed by discussion of lapses in motivation.

- Phase 1: the early rehearsal period. ...
- Phase 2: the later rehearsal period. ...

- Phase 4: immediately following the performance. ...
